

1.1 Privacy Policy

1.2 Cryptalgo Holdings AG ("CRYPTALGO" or "We") is committed to protecting your privacy. In this notice, you can read about the information we collect from you when you visit <https://www.cryptalgo.com> ("Website") and how we use it. If you have any questions or concerns, you can email us at: info@cryptalgo.com.

1.3 In this Privacy Policy we inform you about possible rights you are entitled to. Such rights depend on the data protection laws applicable to us. Therefore, you may have further rights than set forth in this Privacy Policy or certain rights may not be accessible to you. If you do not provide the information requested from us, we may not be able to provide you requested information and the functionality of the Website may be limited.

2. What information do we collect about you?

2.1 This notice applies to all information collected or submitted on the Website. The information we may collect includes:

- Information about (1) your internet connection, (2) the browser type and version used, (3) the operating system used by the accessing the Website, (3) the website from which an accessing system reaches our Website (so-called referrers), (4) the equipment you use to access our Website, (5) and usage details such as date and time of access to the Website;
- Information about your IP addresses, and information collected through cookies and other tracking technologies;
- Your information that you provide us in connection with the contact form. Such information may include (but not limited to) information about your name, your e-mail address, your phone number and other information that voluntarily provided us.
- Your newsletter subscription information such as your e-mail address and name or any other identifier by which you may be contacted online or offline;
- Anonymous usage statistics.

3. What information do we collect through automatic data collection technologies?

3.1 Cookies (or browser cookies). A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our Website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to our Website.

3.2 Flash Cookies. Certain features of our Website may use local stored objects (or Flash cookies) to collect and store information about your preferences and navigation to, from, and on our Website. Flash cookies are not managed by the

same browser settings as are used for browser cookies. For information about managing your privacy and security settings for Flash cookies, visit the Flash player settings page on Adobe's website.

- 3.3 Google Analytics. We use Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. Google Analytics uses cookies (see above) to help us analyze how you and others use the Website. Through the integration of the plugin, Google receives the information that you have called up the corresponding page of our Website. The information generated by the cookie about your use of the Website will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. However, your IP address will be truncated before it is passed on to Google.

- 3.6 Newsletters. If you sign up for our newsletter, which is administered through Mailchimp or similar such provider (Mail Service Provider), or if you register for our Website, we will store some of your information, including your email address, IP address and certain information about the links you click within the emails we send you, on a Mail Service Provider's server. Neither we nor the Mail Service Provider will ever sell your email address or share it with any other party, unless we are legally compelled to do so. If you contact the Mail Service Provider directly regarding your subscription to our newsletter, the Mail Service Provider may contact you directly; otherwise, the Mail Service Provider will never contact you. Only authorized Mail Service Provider's employees have access to our subscriber list. You are always free to unsubscribe from our newsletter, but as long as you are registered with us we may use the Mail Service Provider to send you information about our activities.

- 3.8 LinkedIn. We have integrated components of the LinkedIn Corporation on our Website. LinkedIn is a web-based social network that enables users with existing business contacts to connect and to make new business contacts. Over 400 million registered people in more than 200 countries use LinkedIn. Thus, LinkedIn is currently the largest platform for business contacts and one of the most visited websites in the world.
- 3.9 Each time our Website receives an access request equipped with a LinkedIn component, the component prompts your browser to download an image of this component from LinkedIn. Through this process, LinkedIn is informed exactly which page of our Website is being accessed. By clicking the LinkedIn "recommend button" while logged into your LinkedIn account, you can link content

- 3.11 We have no control over the data that LinkedIn collects thereby, nor over the extent of the data that LinkedIn collects. Nor do we have any knowledge of the content of data transferred to LinkedIn. - 3.12 Telegram. Functions of the Telegram service have been integrated into our website and app. These features are offered by Telegram Messenger LLP., 71-75 Shelton Street, Covent Garden, London, WC2H 9JQ, United Kingdom. When you use Telegram and the “Retweet” function, the websites you visit are connected to your Telegram account and made known to other users. In doing so, data will also be transferred to Telegram. We would like to point out that, as the provider of this Website, we have no knowledge of the content of the data transmitted or how it will be used by Telegram. 4. On what basis we use your information?

- 4.1 We use your personal information on the following bases:
- For legitimate purposes, to better understand the needs, concerns, and interests of our Website visitors and customers so the we can operate optimally and improve the experience on our Website.
 - To perform a contract with you, which we are about to enter into or have entered into, in particular to provide you with information, products or services.
 - To comply with legal and regulatory obligations, in particular to response to subpoenas, court orders, or other legal process, or to establish or exercise our legal rights or to defend against legal claims.
 - We do not use your personal data for activities where our interests are overridden by the impact on you (unless we have your consent or are otherwise required or permitted to by law). You can obtain further information about how we assess our legitimate interests against any potential impact on you in respect of specific activities by contacting us at info@cryptalgo.com. With limited exceptions (for instance, in relation to

some of our marketing and promotion activities), generally we do not rely on consent as the legal basis for processing your personal data.

5. How we use your information?

- 5.1 We use your personal information to get in touch with you (if requested), to deliver products and services to you, and to inform you of our activities, content, and other benefits or opportunities associated with our business. We may also use this information to help us understand our customers' and Website visitors' needs and interests to better tailor our offerings and services to meet your needs.
- 5.2 Sometimes we may use anonymous information about your use of our Website in combination with other users' usage to make decisions about the contents and design of the Website. We may also share these anonymous statistics with potential partners.
- 5.3 We may disclose your information in response to subpoenas, court orders, or other legal process, or to establish or exercise our legal rights or to defend against legal claims.
- 5.4 We may disclose your information when we believe it necessary or desirable in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, violations of our policies, and/or to protect our rights and property.

6. How we share your information with third parties?

- 6.1 As set forth above our Website uses interfaces with social media sites such as Google, Mailchimp, LinkedIn and Telegram. If you choose to share information from our Website through these services, you should review the privacy policy of that service. If you are a member of a social media site, the interfaces may allow the social media site to connect your site visit to your personal data.
- 6.2 We do not reveal your personal data to third-parties for their independent use unless: (1) you request or authorize it; (2) the information is provided to comply with the law (for example, to comply with a search warrant, subpoena or court order), enforce an agreement we have with you, or to protect our rights, property or safety, or the rights, property or safety of our employees or others; (3) to address emergencies or acts of God; or (4) to address disputes, claims, or to persons demonstrating legal authority to act on your behalf.
- 6.3 We may also gather aggregated data about our Website visitors and disclose the results of such aggregated (but not personally identifiable) information to our partners, service providers, advertisers and/or other third parties for marketing or promotional purposes.

7. What are your rights on your information?

- 7.1 The European Union's General Data Protection Regulation and other countries' privacy laws provide certain rights for data subjects.
- 7.2 You can view, edit, or delete your personal data online. If you wish to confirm that we are processing your personal data, or to have access to the personal data we may have about you, please contact us at info@cryptalgo.com. Reasonable access to your personal data will be provided at no cost to you by us. If access cannot be provided within a reasonable time frame, we will provide you with a date when the information will be provided. If for some reason access is denied, we will provide an explanation as to why access has been denied.
- 7.3 You may also request information about: the purpose of the processing; the categories of personal data concerned; who else outside us might have received the data from us; what the source of the information was (if you did not provide it directly to us); and how long it will be stored. You have a right to correct (rectify) the record of your personal data maintained by us if it is inaccurate. You may request that we erase that data, cease or restrict processing it, subject to certain exceptions. In case of automated decision making, including profiling, you may request human intervention or challenge a decision.
- 7.4 In many countries, you have a right to lodge a complaint with the appropriate data protection authority if you have concerns about how we process your Information. When technically feasible, we will — at your request — provide your Information to you or transmit it directly to another controller.

8. How we keep your information safe?

- 8.1 We have put in place systems to safeguard the information you provide to us. We will never provide access to our databases to any third party, except to the extent necessary to conduct the operations of the Website and our activities (see section, What information do we collect through automatic data collection technologies).

9. How long we keep your information?

- 9.1 We process and store the personal data of you only for the period necessary to achieve the purpose of storage, or as far as this is granted by laws or regulations to which we are subject to. The criteria used to determine the period of storage of personal data is the respective statutory retention period. After expiration of that period, the corresponding data is routinely deleted, as long as it is no longer necessary for the fulfillment of the contract or the initiation of a contract.
- 9.2 If the storage purpose is not applicable, or if a storage period prescribed by the European legislator or another competent legislator expires, the personal data are routinely blocked or erased in accordance with legal requirements.
